## **Boarding Rules:**

- All dogs must be current on the following vaccinations:
  - Rabies
  - o Distemper
  - Hepatitis
  - o Parvo
  - o Bordetella
- Valid proof of vaccinations from a veterinarian must be presented before pets can be dropped off for boarding.
- Owners also agree to keep pets on heartworm and flea preventative. *Appropriate action will be taken if pets are found to have arrived with fleas/ticks, at the cost of \$15.00 to the owner.*
- CountrySide Boarding is not responsible for any lost or damaged belongings. Pet owners are advised to label any items left for pet's use.

## **Owners Responsibility:**

- The owner will pay all costs, and charges for special services requested, at time of pick up.
- The owner will provide vaccination records prior to the boarding date. If no vaccination record is provided, Countryside Boarding has the right to refuse services.
- The owner specifically represents that they lawfully own the pets listed in this Pet Boarding Agreement to the best of their knowledge.
- The owner will be held solely responsible for any and all acts or behavior including aggression that takes place during boarding.
- Per state regulation any unclaimed pets will be relinquished to the Franklin County Animal Shelter 14 days after written notice to retrieve the pet has been provided/sent to the owner.

## **Terms and Conditions:**

This Pet Boarding Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with the local and state laws of the County of Franklin in Virginia.

Each party fully consents to the laws of Virginia and, prior to any legal filings, will mediate in good faith to resolve disputes.

**Emergency Medical Care:** The boarding of animals is subject to Article 4 (§ 3.2-6518 et seq.) of Chapter 65 of Title 3.2.

- If your animal becomes ill or injured while in the custody of the boarding establishment, the boarding establishment shall provide the animal with emergency veterinary treatment for the illness or injury. The consumer shall bear the reasonable and necessary costs of emergency veterinary treatment for any illness or injury occurring while the animal is in the custody of the boarding establishment.
- The boarding establishment shall bear the expenses of veterinary treatment for any injury the animal sustains while at the boarding establishment if the injury resulted from the establishment's failure, whether accidental or intentional, to provide the care required by § 3.2-6503.
- Boarding establishments shall not be required to bear the cost of veterinary treatment for injuries resulting from the animal's self-mutilation, or aggression.
- Veterinary Services will be rendered by Franklin County Animal Hospital located in Rocky Mount, Virginia. In the case of non-business hours, services will be rendered by Emergency Veterinary Services located in Roanoke, Virginia.
